General Competition Rules & Regulations

1. Age as of May 1, 2011
2. Entries will be divided into categories after the closing date. The Competition Committee reserves the right to combine, split, or delete/cancel classes or events at their discretion.
3. All competitors must present their current 2011 SOBHD registration cards to receive awards and must remain in costume for all award presentations.
4. No one other than the Competition Committee shall communicate with the judges.
5. Premier competitors may ONLY enter the Premier Highland events provided they are NOT entered in the Provincial Championship.
6. It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian or adult dancer to ensure the competitor is entered in the correct class and age group (age as of May 1, 2011). A forfeit of entry may result if incorrectly submitted. Pre-Premier status changes must be reported to the Competition Committee (780) 922-7414 or email bjprowse@xplornet.com by April 24, 2011. No changes will be made the day of the competition.
7. Entries not properly completed will not be accepted and will be returned. Corrected entries must be returned before the closing date.
8. A separate entry form must be completed for each dancer. Entries to be mailed separately except where there is more than one dancer in a family.
9. Last to enter is the first to dance. Competitors must be on hand when their event is called or may forfeit the right to dance in the event.
10. Protests must be in writing, signed and handed to the Competition Committee before the end of the competition with a \$20.00 fee. The fee is refundable if the protest is sustained.
11. All fees are non-refundable.

Programs and Admissions

Program and admission passes should be ordered and paid for along with entry fees. These may be picked up at the door. Thank you for your cooperation to save us time and your money.

Volunteers

A volunteer schedule will be available on the local and AHDA websites prior to the competition. If you have volunteered, you will be contacted by our coordinator. Once the schedule has been finalized, it will be posted for your convenience.

Thank you to all those who have volunteered to help with this competition and championship. This competition only happens through the volunteer efforts of many people.

Championship Rules & Regulations

1. Alberta Closed Provincial Championships are sanctioned and governed by the rules and regulations of the Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing.
2. As this is a Closed Championship, SOBHD rules state dancers may qualify by birth or having been an Alberta resident for six months immediately prior to this event. However, for eligibility to compete in the Canadian Inter-Provincial Championship (July 2011), ScotDance Canada rules state a dancer may invoke the birth clause only if the dancer is ineligible to compete by residence in any province. In addition, university students may choose to complete in the Closed Provincial Championship or the selection competition of either the Province where they attend school or the Province of their permanent residence, but not both.
3. Draw for position will be set by the competition committee for all dances except the Reel which will be first to enter, last to dance.
4. This is a selection meet for the Inter-Provincial Championships to be held in July 2011 and all competitors must dance according to their age as of 12:01 am July 1, 2011.
5. Championship events must have a minimum of 6 dancers competing to be eligible for Championship status. Up to three dancers may represent Alberta in the Canadian Inter-Provincial Championship, regardless of the number of dancers competing on the day.
6. Only representatives who are full paid members of an AHDA local are eligible for funding.
7. All dancers must dance the 2011 Championship steps.
8. If the Champion and/or Runners up are unable to attend the Canadian Inter-Provincial Championship, the next runner(s) up are eligible.
9. All competitors must present current 2011 SOBHD cards..
10. Dancers must remain in costume for all award presentations.
11. Dancers must fill in for Reels as requested.
12. Perpetual Championship trophies are the property of A.H.D.A. and must be returned eleven months after the competition. Winners are responsible for name engraving and care of the trophy. Damage requiring repair, other than normal maintenance, will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian or adult dancer. Any damage should be reported to the competition committee well in advance of the next event.

Alberta Representatives

Information pamphlets will be available at the end of the Provincial Championships for all dancers who will be representing Alberta at the Inter-Provincial Championships in July 2011.

These dancers are required to remain at the theatre following award presentations for photographs.

Pamphlets from AHDA, EHDA and CHDA will be available with necessary information regarding funding and dancer's responsibilities should they chose to accept their placement as a representative
